

## End-of-Course Testing at a Glance

### **What?**

The Louisiana Department of Education has decided that the EOC test scores will be averaged in with a student's classroom grade to be included as part of his/her final grade for the class. In accordance with DOE directives, Zachary High School will count the EOC exam grade as 15% of each student's final grade for an EOC class.

### **Why?**

The purpose of the EOC assessments is to measure students' academic performance and progress toward postsecondary readiness in core high school courses.

### **Who?**

Students enrolled in Algebra I, Biology, English II and Geometry

### **When?**

May 2<sup>nd</sup> and May 3<sup>rd</sup> – English II

May 4<sup>th</sup> and May 5<sup>th</sup> – Biology

May 9<sup>th</sup> and May 10<sup>th</sup> – Geometry

May 11<sup>th</sup> and May 12<sup>th</sup> – Algebra I

### **How?**

The EOC test is administered in an online format. Each test is administered in two 55 minute sections over a two-day test administration.

### **Special Note:**
