



TESTING DATES

2010-2011

October 13, 2010

- **PSAT:** a practice test for the SAT that gives **11th graders** a chance to enter National Merit Scholarship Corporation scholarship programs
The PSAT measures critical reading skills, math problem-solving skills, and writing skills.

October 18-22, 2010

- **GEE Retest:** all **11th and 12th grade** students who scored “Unsatisfactory” on any section of the GEE will be given the retest

November 18, 2010

- **“Plan” Test:** a comprehensive guidance resource that helps **10th graders** measure their current academic development, explore career/training options, and make plans for the remaining years of high school and post-graduation years

January 12, 2011

- **ASVAB:** a series of tests and an interest inventory, developed by the Department of Defense, to **help 10th, 11th, and 12th graders** predict future academic and occupational success in both military and civilian occupations

March 22, 2011

- **LEAP and GEE:** all **8th, 10th, and 11th grade** students will be tested on constructed response items
Any **12th grade student** who scored “Unsatisfactory” on the GEE in Oct. 2010 will also be tested.

April 11-14, 2011

- **LEAP and GEE:** all **8th, 10th, and 11th grade** students will be tested
Any **12th grade student** who scored “Unsatisfactory” on the GEE in Oct. 2010 will also be tested.

May 2-20, 2011

- **End of Course:** a standardized test given at the end of the school year to students enrolled in Algebra I, Biology, English II, English III, and Geometry

May 2-11, 2011

- **AP Exams:** tests that give **12th graders** the opportunity to earn credit at most of the nation’s colleges and universities
Chemistry (5/2), Calculus (5/4), Eng Lit & Comp (5/5), US History (5/6),
Biology, Music Theory, & Physics (5/9), Eng Lang & Comp (5/11), World History (5/12)
